



Student Information Release Authorization

In compliance with the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 and Louisiana Act 837, educational institutions are prohibited from providing certain personal identifiable information from your student records to a third party.

This restriction applies, but is not limited, to your parents, your spouse, or a sponsor. You may, at your discretion, grant permission to release information about your student records to a third party by submitting a completed Student Information Release Authorization. If you are under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must certify by signature the authorization for information release.

This form authorizes release of student's full name, birth date, school attending, email address and home address. This form only authorizes the release of said information to Agriculture Education Services and Technology (AEST), Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation, and the Louisiana FFA Association. It cannot be used to authorize a standing release of information.

The specified information will be made available only to AEST, The Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation and The Louisiana FFA Association for the sole purpose of testing and certifying students in the Industry based Credential known as Louisiana Agriculture Tech.
